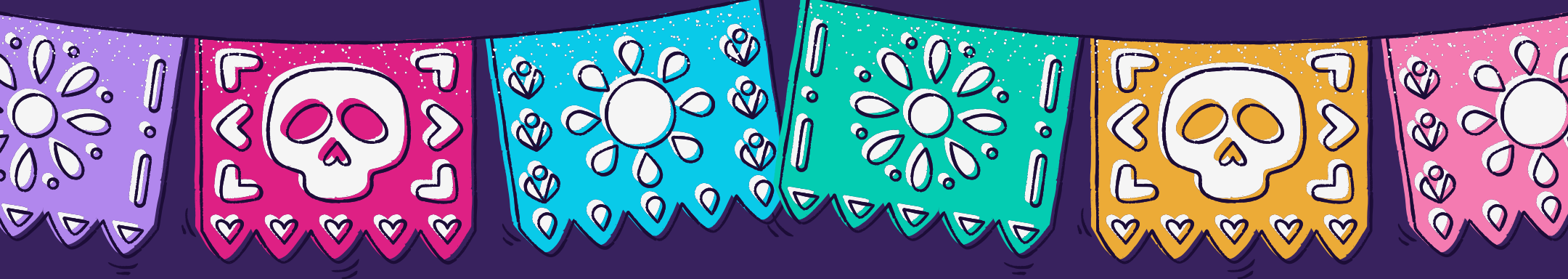

LIVING WAX MUSEUM PROJECT

You will be participating in a Catholic Saint wax museum! This activity requires you to research a Catholic Saint. You will get to choose the person to portray, but you must get teacher approval before proceeding with the project. This will help eliminate having everyone choose the same Saint. The “living wax museum” is a collection of visual displays where students, dressed as famous individuals, stand at attention, while visitors walk around and tour exhibits illustrating the life of the Saint you choose.

STEP 1:

CHOOSE A SAINT YOU WOULD LIKE TO RESEARCH. EMAIL MRS. HEATHER TO DOUBLE CHECK NO ONE ELSE HAS TAKEN THAT SAINT.



STEP 3 :

**PRACTICE SAYING YOUR SAINT NAME, DATE OF BIRTH
AND IMPORTANT FACTS TO YOUR FAMILY**



STEP 4:

FROM RESEARCH, YOU WILL PUT TOGETHER A SIMPLE COSTUME THAT REPRESENTS THE PERSON YOU ARE PORTRAYING. YOU MAY ALSO USE PROPS TO HELP YOU DEPICT THE FIGURE. THE COSTUME WILL BE WORN DURING THE PRESENTATION.

STEP 5:

ON THE LIVING WAX MUSEUM DAY, YOU WILL SET UP A STATION COMPLETE WITH POSTERS, PROPS, ETC. YOU WILL HAVE YOUR PRESENTATION NOTES HANDY. YOU WILL ALSO HAVE A "BUTTON" THAT GUESTS WILL PRESS IN ORDER TO HAVE YOU START SAYING YOUR ORAL PRESENTATION (WE WILL BE MAKING THE 'BUTTONS' IN CLASS).

STEP 6:

INVITED STUDENTS, PARENTS, AND PARISHIONERS WILL VISIT THE MUSEUM. WHEN THE GUESTS PASS THE HISTORICAL FIGURE AND PUSH THE BUTTON, YOU WILL RECITE YOUR "SPEECH". YOU SHOULD REMAIN "IN CHARACTER" AT ALL TIMES DURING THE LIVING WAX MUSEUM.

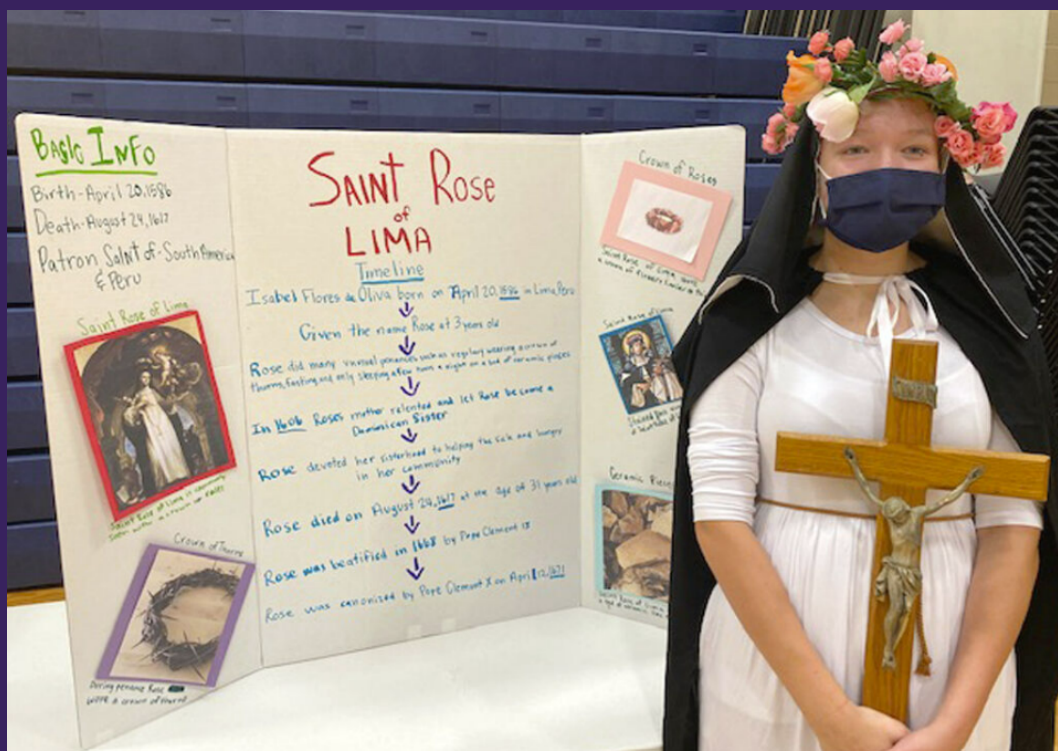
Step 4:

Put together a simple costume that represents your Saint. You will process in during mass and stay for the Wax Museum presentation.



Step 5:

On the Living Wax Museum Day, you will set up a station complete with your trifold, props, etc. You will also have a “button” that parishioners will press in order to have you start saying your oral presentation (name of Saint and facts).
