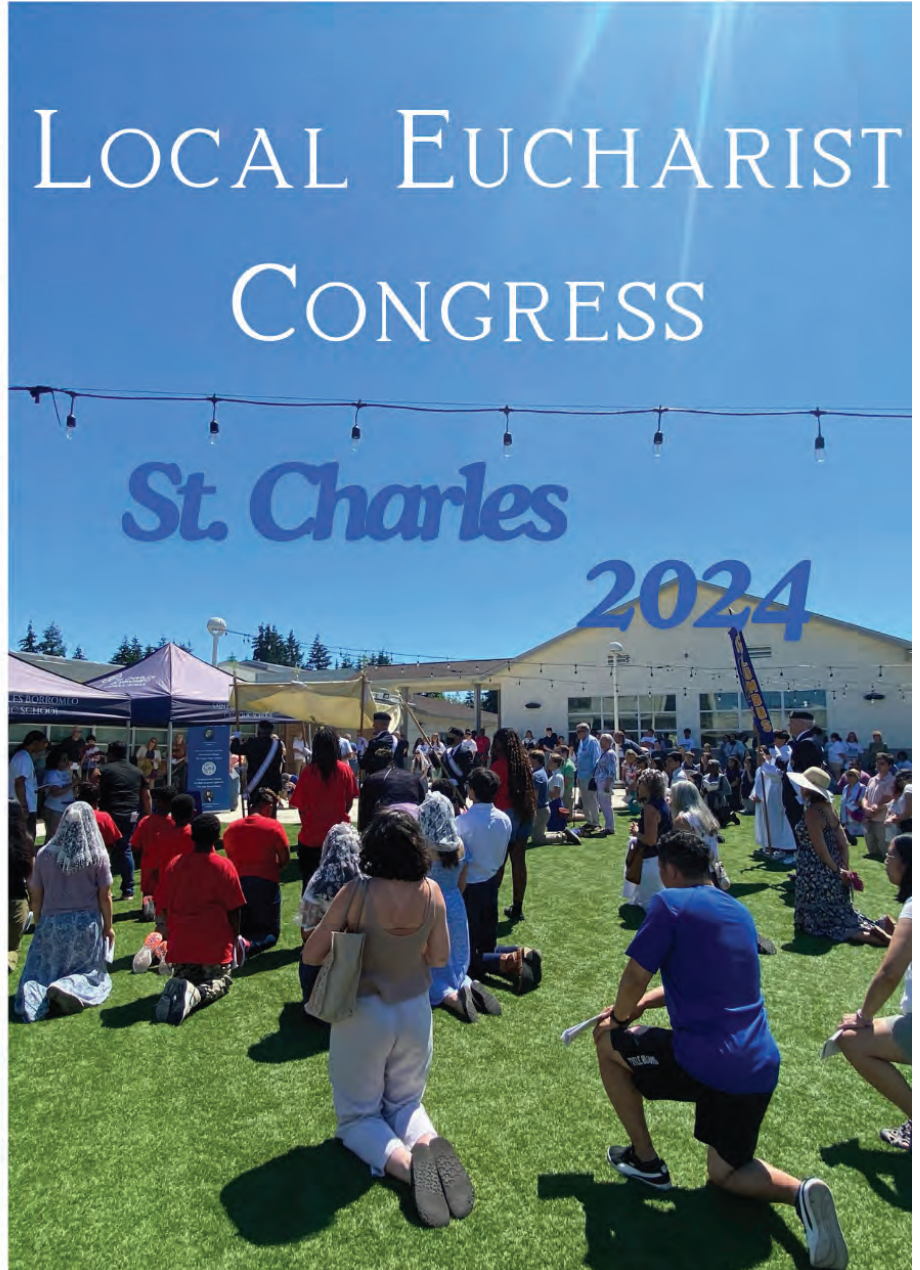

Clothing Boutique/ Social Supportive Services: A New Parish Season

Approaches

Social Supportive Services:

Social Supportive Services has been shut down for a few weeks as is our summer tradition. Staff & Volunteers will be meeting Friday July 26th to discuss the program and find ways to improve the ministry. My heartfelt thanks to all the volunteers who allow us to have these great parish ministries. Without the fantastic support from our dedicated and skilled volunteers, these ministries (Soc. Serv./Boutique) would not be possible. THANK YOU!

The current financial situation for Supportive Social Services is good. As of the writing of this report, we have \$70,700.00 in the account. We plan to stay within a \$5,000 - \$6,000 monthly budget. This will allow us to have some cushion in the account when we feel that it is just and compassionate to occasionally go beyond the monthly budget benchmarks. We also rely on the ongoing financial support from the parish via monthly donations to the program. Over the years, parishioner's financial support has been remarkable. We have been able to address the needs of others in ways that have been truly helpful to them and to their families. You have been the Gospel of Good News to so many over the years! Again, THANK YOU!

Clothing Boutique:

The Boutique has been going non-stop through the summer. We have spent considerable amount of time over the past few months going through donations and organizing our stock of clothing for those who come for help, especially those living on the street.

Our donation stack has diminished, and we are in need of a few items:

- Men's underwear – sizes medium to large
- Toothbrushes
- Men's jeans – sizes 32"-38" waist

L'Honey & Youth Garden

L'Honey - We will conduct another round of hive inspections and will begin the feeding of any weak hives to help them out. Starting the 1st week of August, we will release all caged queens and conduct Varroa Mite treatments. Please keep the honeybees in your prayers!

Youth Garden – We will make our 1st batch of pickled beets this Sunday at Bix Hall. More beet seed has been planted - hopefully a 2nd crop in Sept. NOTE: We are happy to receive any donations of beets that you have grown. Also, get ready for the Black berry picking season!!!

Additionally, we have begun planning on a new project – St. Leo Youth Grape Arbor. Our hope is that the grape arbor will bear not only grapes but help our youth see the natural connection between God's Creation and the Eucharist.
