



St. Leo Property Updates, April 2025

Last week's bulletin included a page on St. Leo Property Updates, April 2025. As was noted in the Campus Safety section in that update a construction project that will replace the failed retaining wall at South 13th and G Streets and fencing of the campus will start soon.

On Thursday April 24, Temporary fencing will be installed at the perimeter of St. Leo's property along G street from corner of 13th and G and on 13th St. to the driveway entrance on S 13th St. On Monday April 28, the demolition of the failed retaining wall will begin. We expect continued construction activity in this area over the next several months.

We will provide further updates as construction proceeds.

Seeking a Place to Call Home: "Needle in a Haystack"

We are all aware that, for the most part, affordable housing for those of little means is non-existent. However, the need is real, personal and is a major moral challenge. The normal avenues through which to secure housing have NOT shown any promise regarding an elderly couple and their adult son. Their son is working and is simply living with his parents to help share the burden of the cost of living and to help attend to the health needs of his aging parents.

I know this good family and they are facing the horrific eventuality of eviction through no fault of their own. The building in which they live is slated for sale and major renovations. It is not up to code and should not be occupied by anyone under its current condition.

This family is financially impoverished, but the love they have for each other is so rich and so rare in these times of indifference. My heart is broken by seeing these good people, my neighbors, in such a state of fear and distress. As I write this, I am reminded of the *Wounds of Christ* and the promise of *Easter Hope*. I think of my dear Pope Francis and his love of the poor. I pray for help regarding this family of three that have gone through so much together just to find a place to live in peace.

I am exhausted and have found no avenues to affordable housing for this family. I am asking the parish to please let me know of any housing arrangement that you may know to help these good people in such desperate times. 
