# A Message from Father Michael

Thank you for your commitment to caring for the people on the margins. I am truly impressed by all the work our parish family does to follow the Gospel mandate to care for the least among us. A small sample of those ministries includes:

- Food Connection feeding 275 people a day
- St. Vincent DePaul offering \$10K per month to families in need
- Clothing Boutique providing clothes and laundry services to over three dozen people a day
- Respect Life and Spiritual Adoption ministries proclaiming the dignity of every human life
- Mercy 253 providing care to the homeless and mothers in need through Next Chapter

This is just a partial list and it doesn't include the support we offer to Catholic Community Services and the Archdiocesan Housing Authority. Thank you for this important witness you offer.

## **A commitment to our ministries**

With the Partners in the Gospel process underway, it's natural to be concerned about the future of these ministries, along with others. However, as your Pastor, I am happy to encourage you that, while we probably aren't going to add new ministries until we are much further in the Partners in the Gospel process, we remain committed to supporting our current ministries. Catholic Social Teaching tells us that it is very important to honor the good work that the people of our parish have done in response to the needs they observe in our community.

I also want to emphasize that our parish family will support each principle of Catholic Social Teaching. Our Respect Life ministries and our service to the poor are part of a comprehensive whole of our response to the Gospel. I think it's important that each remain part of our mission as a parish.

## **Solidarity flows from relationship**

As we form our new parish family, there will be opportunities for our ministries to work together. I am excited to see this happen. At the same time, it is important to me that collaboration flow from relationship and it takes time to form those relationships. Furthermore, it is important that those relationships can form without the pressure of the need to combine ministries. If you appreciate one of our parish ministries, be assured that we aren't going to force changes to these ministries. We want you to keep doing the important work you are doing with confidence.

## **Collaborating with the Archdiocese and following best practices**

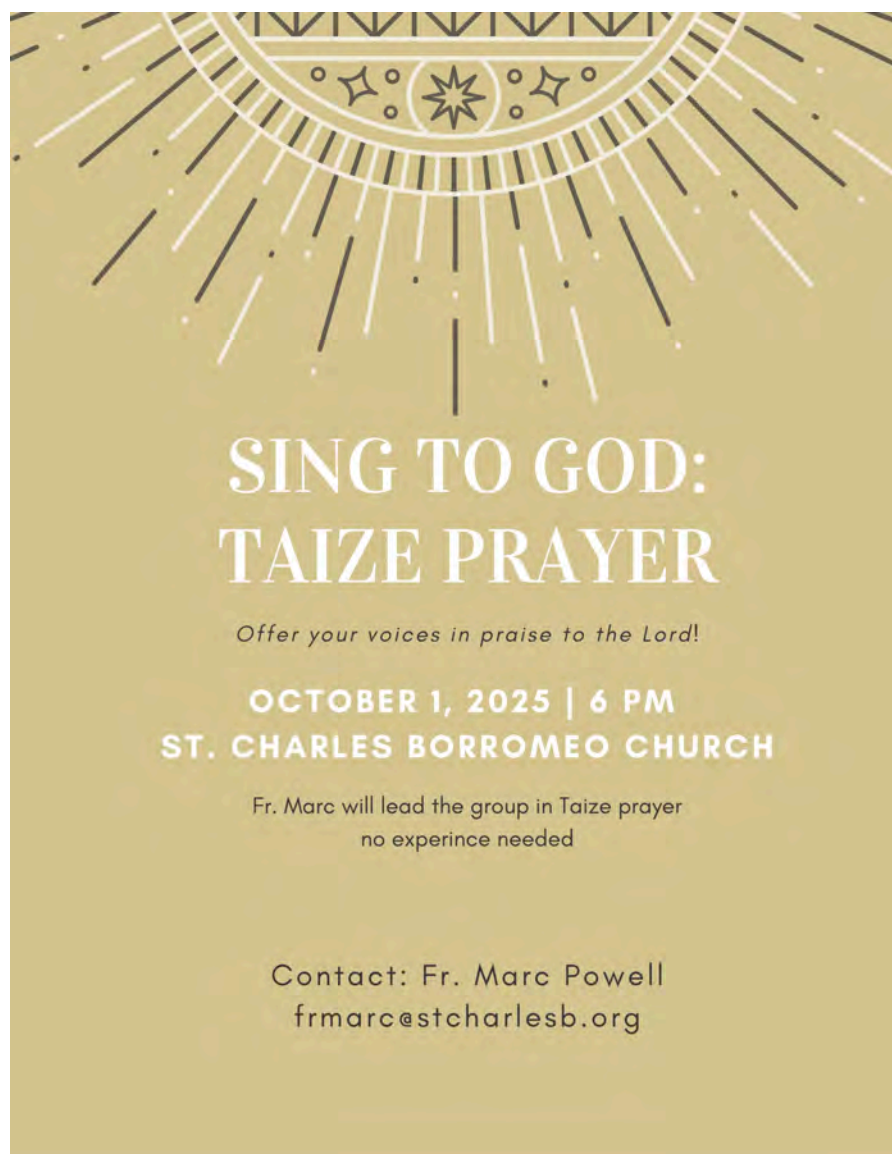

## SACRAMENTAL PREP 2<sup>ND</sup> GRADE & UP

### at St. Leo

Classes take place on select Sundays following 10am Mass. Classes are offered in Spanish only.

### at St. Charles

Classes take place on select Sundays following 10am Mass. Classes are offered in English and have an at-home component available in both English and Spanish. Students enrolled in a Catholic School need only to complete the at-home preparation.

## CONFIRMATION PREP 7<sup>TH</sup> TO 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

Preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation takes place beginning in 7th grade for those children who have received the Sacrament of the Eucharist. Youth may select the preparation program that best fits their schedule and needs.

Classes take place on select Sundays following 10am Mass in Spanish only. Additionally, Youth Masses will be held once per month at St. Charles 12:30pm Mass with an activity following Mass.

### at St. Patrick

Classes take place on select Sundays from 10:15-Noon. Classes are in English only.

**SESSION # 10 TOPIC: FORGIVENESS**  
**W/ ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA**

Josephine Bakhita was born in Sudan, she was kidnapped at the age of 7, sold into slavery. She was resold several times, finally in 1883 to an Italian family. Josephine felt drawn to the Catholic Church. She was baptized and confirmed in 1890, taking the name Josephine. Saint Josephine Bakhita entered the Institute of St. Magdalene of Canossa in 1893 and made her profession, where she assisted her religious community through cooking, sewing, embroidery, and welcoming visitors at the door. She soon became well loved by the children attending the sisters' school and the local citizens. She once said, "Be good, love the Lord, pray for those who do not know Him. What a great grace it is to know God!"

## **St. Leo Property Updates, September 2025**

Our construction project replacing the failed retaining wall at South 13<sup>th</sup> and G Streets and fencing of the campus is well underway. A new retaining wall designed by structural and Geotechnical engineers has been completed.

- Expect one-lane and some full closures of the 14<sup>th</sup> street entrance to the campus Monday 9/8, Tuesday 9/9, and Wednesday 9/10 for gate installation work. Please enter and exit at the 13<sup>th</sup> Street driveway during this time.
- Monday September 8, Bollards at the 13<sup>th</sup> Street driveway new gate location will be installed. Additionally, bollards will be installed adjacent to the Food Connection outdoor waiting area to protect Food Connection families awaiting entry to pick up food. Bollards will also be installed near the church's main entrance to protect parishioners entering and exiting the church.
- The twenty parking spaces on the East perimeter of the parking lot will be closed and unavailable during working hours, Monday 9/8 through Friday 9/12 to allow for fencing construction (in line with the top of the G Street retaining wall, refrigeration trailer to the south border fence).
- The parking area between the former St. Leo School (Tahoma Center) and the Church remains closed for storage of fencing materials prior to their installation. The closure is expected to continue until early October. Please note that pedestrian access to the church from the Yakima Avenue steps into this area will be closed during this period also. Neighborhood Clinic access will be enabled only during clinic hours of operation.
- Parking lot lighting repairs and gate electrical work will begin Wednesday 9/17. Fence installation is continuing and is expected to be mostly complete by early October; however, a few fencing components will not arrive until October extending completion to mid-November.
- As you may recall upgrading the fencing and closing campus nighttime access was recommended by law enforcement and security consultants as a necessary step to address thefts, property destruction, vandalism, and other crimes costing tens of thousands of dollars per year. The cost of improving the fencing around the campus is being shared with Catholic Community Services.

We will provide further updates as construction proceeds.

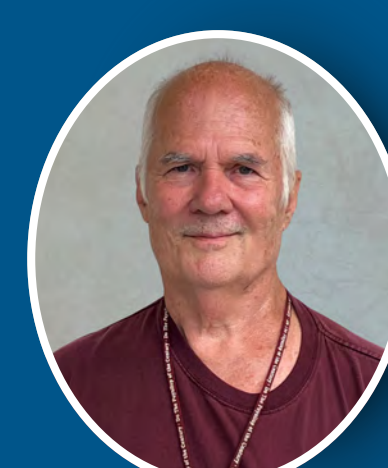

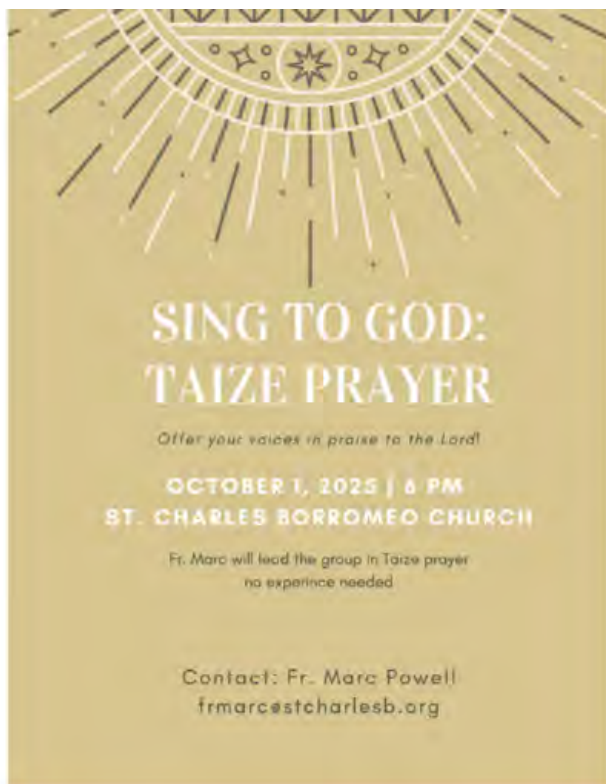
