

## ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Contrary to belief, an anointing is not just for those who are actively dying. One can receive an anointing if they are severely ill, are about to have surgery, are actively dying or any other emergency circumstances.

If you or your family member have been Baptized Catholic, and are in need of an anointing please call the office at 253-564-5185. If you are in need of an anointing for someone who is actively dying (outside office hours), please call the emergency line at 253-564-5185. and press 2.

Attending Mass and in need of an anointing? No problem. Fr. Michael and Fr. Marc welcome you to be anointed after any Mass! Just stand/sit by the Baptismal font and they will meet you after Mass.

## GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

Pope Leo has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land, where they are now less than 2% of the population. 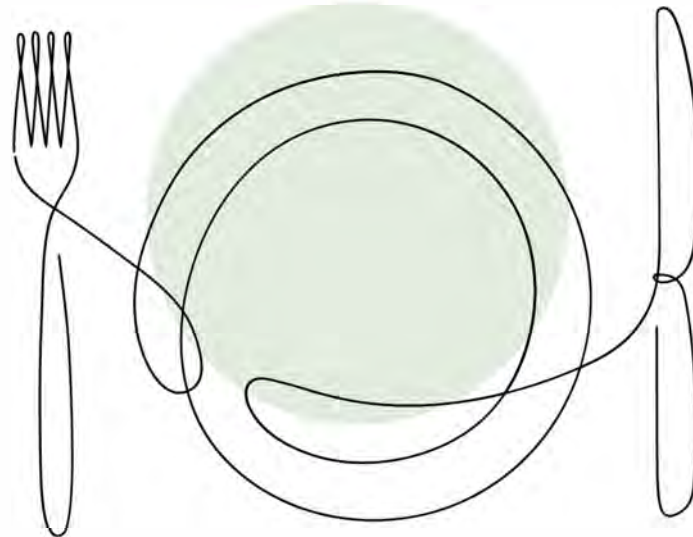

## The Office of Tenebræ

The name Tenebræ (the Latin word for darkness or shadows) is an ancient monastic tradition based on night and early morning services (Matins and Lauds) of the last three days of Holy Week, which in medieval times came to be celebrated on the preceding evenings. Apart from the chanting of the Lamentations of Jeremiah, in which each verse is introduced by a letter of the Hebrew alphabet, the most conspicuous feature of the service is the gradual extinguishing of candles and other lights in the church to signify the darkness that overshadowed the earth at Christ's crucifixion. The loud noise, or strepitus, at the conclusion of the service suggests the earthquake described in the Passion narratives. The single candle left burning is the symbol and promise of Christ's triumph over death and darkness. The service acts as a somber reflection on the final days of Jesus, from the Last Supper to his burial. The service is designed to evoke the emotional weight of Passion Week.
