## PARISH UPDATES

### RECRUITING & REGIONAL PASTORAL ASSISTANT FOR ADMINISTRATION

#### **What is a Regional Pastoral Assistant for Administration?**

Every organization develops its own job "titles" to describe a job in a precise way. Of course, outside the organization, these titles can be unfamiliar. But they can also be very helpful in understanding the work.

Because the Church organizes the life of a parish under the leadership of a Pastor, many jobs in the Church are described as "Pastoral Assistant" because the essence of our work is to support the leadership of a Pastor who is a delegate of the Archbishop.

This position of Pastoral Assistant is responsible for key administrative responsibilities, particularly financial management. A successful person in this role will be able to work with a balance sheet and profit and loss statement and know how to effectively manage bookkeeping processes. This position will play a key role in ensuring transparency and accountability.

Additionally, the position will oversee the management of our facilities. This is a very important job when you consider all the buildings and grounds that need to be maintained at the campuses of St. Charles and St. Leo. Both sites demand a great deal of attention with the largest school in the Archdiocese at St. Charles as well as the busy and diverse social services programs like the Food Connection at St. Leo. Caring for these properties requires a lot of organization and attention.

There's more to the job as well: supporting development and fundraising at both sites and for the many diverse ministries; managing Information Technology (IT) support; ensuring proper record keeping; and best stewardship of parish resources.

The "Regional" part of the job means that the person in this position must support these important functions at both St. Charles and St. Leo. This increases the complexity of the job. It requires attention and support for two different and very active communities.

#### **Looking for someone committed to the work of the Church**

We're looking for someone who truly understands the work of the Church and can engage and support the many volunteers who support and lead our parish community. And, given the many responsibilities of the job, it can be seen how success in it will require a little help from above!
